

# Ethics PowerPoint

For this assignment, I would like for you to create a PowerPoint based on the ethics / narrative ethics article you were assigned this week. The article is your primary source; you are welcome to use material from last week and / or any of the articles from this week as secondary support.

**Purpose:** Often, those with an MA or in some cases, an MSN will find themselves doing research and presenting either to their peers and colleagues in the workplace or to their peers at workshops and conferences.

**Audience / Context:** The context for this PowerPoint is that you are giving a presentation to your colleagues on the on the topic of ethics/medical ethics/narrative ethics.

Think about the audience in this case - your peers. What does that group look like? (This should be field specific - so if you're an MSN major, most likely you're speaking to other medical professionals including physicians - and your audience might run the spectrum to include all ancillary professions that might be interested in the subject.)

If you're not an MSN major, then think about conferences you might attend either as a graduate student or as a professional. For instance, if you're working on an MA in English, you could easily encounter this subject at the Association of Teachers of Technical Writing conference; or at the Rhetoric Society of America Conference, the MLA conference and numerous others. If you're pursuing a degree in any of the social sciences, you could encounter this topic at the International Conference On Humanities & Social Sciences. This topic isn't confined to healthcare, nor writing, nor writing in healthcare and is often explored by diverse peoples and fields.

So think about your audience: What do they know? What do you want them to know? What gaps might you have to fill in? What's the best way to do that? Conference presentations usually run about 15-20 minutes - which means you can't just duplicate the article and talk your way through it. Keep it neat, readable, professional.
